In order to obtain the qualification and use the designatory letters CAT (Certified Accounting Technician) after your name, you must also satisfy the appropriate practical financial work experience requirement (1 Year).

Successful completion of the ACCA exams offers automatic transfer to Part 2 of the ACCA Qualification. This leads to an Oxford Brooks Honours BSc in Applied Accounting.
