Career Opportunities & Academic Progression

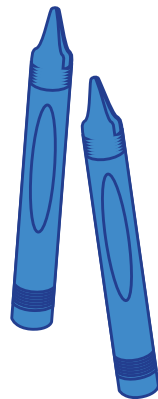
The Advanced Certificate in Supervision in Childcare Course will equip participant with the skills, knowledge and competence required to supervise in an early childhood education and care setting and support others in their role and performance. The course provides an excellent progression route to further education and subject to specific requirements the course can be used to apply through the CAO for a third level degree course in a related discipline - Bachelor or Honours Degree in Early Childhood Education. Graduates will have highly sought after skills within the area of childcare supervision.

Pre-requisites

This course is open to all with general work/life experience. Participants should be in occupational roles sufficient to allow them reflect upon the practical implications of supervising in the context of a childcare setting.

Principal Areas of Study

The Aim of the Advanced Certificate in Childcare is to:

- Acquire an understanding of early childhood programmes.
- Develop an awareness of social and legal issues which relate directly to and impact on early childhood education and care settings.
- Enhance professional communication skills to promote effective interaction with all stakeholders.

- Early Childhood Programmes
- Supervision in Childcare
- Social and Legal Issues in Childcare

Elective Modules

Learners will need to bring forward two FETAC Level 5 modules or complete another elective FETAC Level 6 Module in Communications (outlined below) to achieve their Major Award.

Communications Level 6

All participants must have access to a professional Childcare environment to fulfill the assessment requirements of the course - which is at least 100 hours work experience.
