Course Overview

To develop an awareness of the context for training and development, and the key issues that impact on its planning and delivery. To enable training and development professionals to develop their expertise to understand, identify, deliver and evaluate training within their organisation.

- Work effectively with a range of learner groups
- Design, deliver and evaluate training programmes
- Develop and implement appropriate assessment methods
